Fundraising Reimbursements:

Budget from Crystal for the Raiders Provincial Tournament as it was discussed last meeting and it was unclear as to what we should be doing for the extra fundraising money.

I have looked at the fundraising policy for provincials and also the other questions about reimbursement and this is what I found:

- The dollars that teams will **not have to share** are the dollars made from 50/50's throughout the season or tournaments in which the team has hosted.

I read this as anything that was a donation from a business or a fundraiser etc needs to stay in the provincial account to be shared.

- Teams will submit a cost breakdown of expenses and funds will be allocated accordingly to assist or cover expenses. Expense priorities will be (in order given)

Accommodations
Provincial Expenses- team banquet, team banner
Travel
Team dinner

Then when I look at the basic fundraising guidelines I see these two things

- Parental Contributions is defined as: any money collected from the team parents to cover the cost of team expenses, i.e. tournament fees, socks etc.
- Fundraising dollars are to be used for the teams to attend tournaments or approved team functions
- If teams have an excess amount of dollars held in trust, **only parental contributions will be reimbursed.** The parental contributions and the fundraising will cover all tournaments attended or approved team functions, not necessarily will the entire amount contributed will be reimbursed. All team expenses must first be covered.

From the Raiders budget breakdown, reimbursement payments were made for the different things that the team was allowed to use from fundraising for already.

This doesn't really answer the question but it's what is in the policies.

New Business

- 1. Letter from Fernie re Female Hockey Jason Lui reviewed the letter with those present. Their letter has many options and detailed their players plans. All looking at different options for play. Cranbrook is looking at putting in U11A female and EVMHA U15B. Rocky Mount league excited of the potential of more teams. If we cant come up with enough players for this season and RML there is no cost or obligation and would be happy for us to try again next season. Jason thinks the numbers do support a U15 team. Discussion of where RML play happens and how we always have to travel anyways so it is not a big change. In BC hockey bylaws in regards to females. BC hockey allows for dual carding. Discussion about making sure players are aware of the challenges of playing on 2 teams if they still want to play integrated. Jason will follow up with a survey similar to Fernie focusing more
- 2. U7/U9 Tournaments. Stephanie Doratty. U7 tourney planning last season was challenging. Very stressful. Only had 3 teams sign up for 5 teams total. U9 tourney had same issue. Low attendance tourney the last several years. Going in to next year with inexperienced planners. Had proposed to follow Creston and do 1 home tourney for U7/U9 combined. Less expensive overall with more parents, great mentorship, lots of families with players in both U7 and U9. More attractive for visiting teams. Tentative schedule shown to board. Jeff P, what are the benefits for the players? Discussion on logistics, is it fair to have tourney in Sparwood and make Elkford go there. Maybe do a survey asking parents what is required? Will do a survey after reg to see what parents and coaches prefer. Book both weekends as per normal.
- 3. Registration. Update on who can register to tryout for Bucks, U13, female, U15, U18. Need to get our reg open. Fees, should they go up? Players need to reg at home before they can reg for tryouts. Older age groups U11-U15 they are paying more than what we give them, lower they are laying less than what we give them. Ice costs going up both arenas. Sparwood ice open to April 14 this season, 30 weeks instead of 25 weeks. Reg includes ref fees, games, ice, EK fees have gone up from \$4 to \$12.
