#### **OLD BUSINESS**

1. Policies- attached and vote on policies

Jenna added a form for the team, for dual rostering, AP, for the policies. Clarifying about fees for registration fees for dual rostering, discussed that the players pay the full registration minus the HCR fee. Clarifying that the primary team is the priority, Jenna also added to include a trial period of 4 practices for Affiliated Players. Jenna Kaus motion the discussed that the affiliated players pay the full registration minus the HCR fee. - (Jenna) After giving it some thought and talking to a few managers, I wondered why we would buy a Round Robin Board but not the standings. - 3. (Jillian) After the meeting I was thinking of feedback from the members and protection of privacy.

I had two thoughts. Could we use a mailbox or mail slot in the storage equipment room doors? And have someone check it weekly at a practice in both Sparwood and Elkford or if we have more executive volunteers, it could be checked twice a week during regular season. Also, we could provide a survey at the end of the year to be emailed out to our 2022/2023 members. As these are a suggestion of mine, I volunteer to take lead on both of these initiatives. Was discussed that an email address will be sufficient.

Motion to create an email for feedback and Nikole Sharpe volunteered to man the feedback email.

4. (Jillian) Team snap- if we go through registration straight through the HCR will we have any scheduling, communication device in place of? I just think we as a team use Team Snap ALOT. Have the managers been asked if they use it?

Can we still register directly with HCR and pay for team snap to use for webpages, scheduling and communication?

Team Snap was discussed, Stephanie Dorratty will look into HCR and the future of using only the HCR. Stephanie to discuss with other teams that have made the transition. So this will be discussed after the 2023/2024 season.

- 5. Sparwood Elkford Hockey days (motioned to bring up at this meeting from last) It was discussed that the special events coordinator to make the plan for events next season.
- 6. Tiffany mentioned that she attended an EK meeting and discussion around the Cranbrook zones and bucks moving to Alberta instead of the Okanagan league.

#### **New Business**

- (Jillian) I am not too sure that this is a concern but at a game we had in Elkford a player from the other team had a stick caught in the board, I am pretty sure it was a freak occurrence and the likelihood of it happening again may be slim, but it made me wonder when the last time the arenas were inspected by our risk manager? Risk Manager to review and will do an inspection at the end of the season when the ice will be out, and again at the beginning of the season to follow up.
- (Desiree) Proposal for Tournament Proceeds
   Desiree came to meeting to discuss the tournament proposal and she came from FMHA and
   wanted to share and what she learnt and wanted to propose EACH team receives a
   maximum of \$1500.00 from tournament revenues. Attached Tournament Proceeds Policy

Question and clarification- How would the \$750 to the team before the tournament work if the tournament doesn't go through? Would need to created Discussed the gaming parameters and what the purpose of the tournament is it a fundraiser.

### Two concerns:

One, the money itself raised by the fundraising/raffle can only be spent on what the license was pulled for (the running of the tournament). If the money raised surpasses what the tournament actually cost to run, then that extra money couldn't go "back to the team" based on BCLC rules, unless the specifics are put on the license.

Two, it is hard to say if the 1500 "top up" would be feasible for long for the association. As of right now, for the 2022/2023 season there is a current "profit" of 1246.66 for the season with all of the proceeds from the U7/U9 and U11 Tournaments in the account. This also doesn't include the rest of the year's ice rentals, banquet, or other gifts/etc.

That being said, there were a few extra fees that we incurred this year (unexpected) and last year's season appears to have pulled in a pretty significant profit overall from what I can glean from the QuickBooks report.

Tanya motions that each hosting team of EVMH pays \$500 1<sup>st</sup> Stephanie Frieheit, 2<sup>nd</sup> Jenna Kaus all in favor

3. Smart Lock- Sky wants to propose smart locks on equipment doors and lockers looking at both Dead bolts and padlocks. Sky is going to look at cost, and permission from both Districts.

- 4. Banquets- In the past Crystal split up two events for numbers. Tanya texted Justin Hart to see if Elkford Community Centre is available April 30th or May 7th Events coordinator to pick a date and come back with a date of either April 30th or May 7th. 1<sup>st</sup> session initiation, U7 and U9 2<sup>nd</sup> Session U11s, U13 and U15s Awards to be ordered, forms to the teams and food ordered and plan in place.
