

## **EVMHA Jersey Care and Maintenance Information for Jersey Parents**

Every season, each team will appoint a jersey parent to take care of the team jerseys.

Responsibilities of the jersey parent include:

### During the Season

- Distribute and collect jerseys before and after every game. No player should ever go home with their jersey.
- It is recommended that the jersey parent bring both the home and away jerseys to every game (in case of a colour conflict with the opposing team).
- Normal wear and tear are expected while playing hockey, but every effort must be made to keep jerseys in good condition.
- If a jersey is damaged or cut during a game, the jersey parent must contact the EVMHA equipment manager ASAP to arrange a replacement. Families will not be responsible for replacement costs under these circumstances.
- Jerseys should be washed regularly.
  - o Use cold water and hang to dry – DO NOT PUT IN THE DRYER!

### Post Season

- Jerseys must be returned at the end of the season with the following expectations:
  - o Jerseys must be in their designated garment bag.
  - o Jerseys must be on a wire hanger.
  - o Jerseys are washed.
  - o All name bars and C/A's removed.
  - o All loose threads were removed.
